Rubanda Solidarity School is composed of nursery and primary sections. It started in 2004 with only a baby class as a study year project. In 2005, the nursery and primary school was opened, offering a day and boarding program. The number and different age groups of children necessitated the structure of a three year nursery class (baby, middle and top class). I thank Fr. Dominic, Coordinator and our friends for the work done in order to up lift the standards of Rubanda Solidarity Nursery School.

Our first children of top class sat for primary leaving examination in 2012. And those who were in middle class also sat for primary leaving examination in November 2013. We thank God for the idea that when the top class children are ready to join the primary section they graduate from the nursery section. This started in 2011 where we had twenty four graduands (twelve boys and twelve girls) and has helped our school to progress. In 2012 we had 25 graduands (fifteen boys and ten girls). This year, 2013, we have twenty graduands (twelve boys and eight girls).

We ask God to bless our school, parents, teachers, Administration, children and friends.

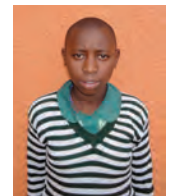
